Vision Subcommittee Meeting Minutes  
November 2, 2017**

1. Call to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. Roll call.
3. Motion to approve minutes of the October meeting by Mikie, second by Bob. Approved unanimously.
4. Public forum: No topics raised.
5. Chair's Report: Jeff reported that the Vision Traffic Report was approved by SONC on October 9<sup>th</sup>. He and Ron Ziff presented the Report to Assemblymember Adrin Nazarian on October 23<sup>rd</sup>, will meet with Councilmember David Ryu on November 3<sup>rd</sup> and Senator Hertzberg on November 6<sup>th</sup>. Maria has spoken with Brian Gallagher and expects to meet and review our concepts possibly in January or February.

The High Density Housing Report was approved by PLUM on October 19<sup>th</sup>. We have comments from Tom Glick, and the Report will be presented to the SONC Board on November 13<sup>th</sup>.

Maria provided an update about the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration. The banners and cutout from the celebration are currently on display on the first level at Fashion Square. The team from the mall reports that they are generating great interest and we should be able to keep them there for at least another month and possibly longer until the space where they are placed is rented.

6. New Business: The Vision Committee and the Green & Beautification Committee will jointly study the potential bikeway and pedestrian opportunities along the LA River. Jeff shared a presentation of the current status of the bikeway plans, and detailed views of certain locations. He asked the Committee to go see the sites and be prepared to bring creative ideas to the December meeting.

7. Committee Business: Giulio shared a study showing of high density housing ideas previously discussed and incorporated into the High Density Housing Report. The study provides a visual depiction under various square footage and site coverage scenarios.

Jeff shared a Vision Project Summary report that Tom and Maria put together. The report shows all the various projects the Committee is working on, when they were initiated and where they stand in the process of vetting with various stakeholders and advancing along. The Committee provided feedback.
