Motion to LA City Council – Street Banners for Sherman Oaks

The Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council was granted its charter on October 29th, 2002. The Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council is celebrating its 20th anniversary beginning October 29th, 2022. As a part of this celebration, and to conduct outreach and promote the Neighborhood Council process and function, SONC is requesting that the Council District 4 Councilmember Nithya Raman introduce the following motion to the Los Angeles City Council:

The Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council is coordinating a street banner campaign. The purpose of which is to promote the Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council and encourage stakeholders to become involved with the Sherman Oaks Community and city government.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council, in accordance with the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 62.132, approve the street banner program being coordinated by the Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council, as a City of Los Angeles Non-event Street Banner Program for the period of October 14, 2022 – October 14, 2023.
